

SAIT Campus Access Safety Information

You play a key role in keeping yourself and others safe while on campus.

If you are not feeling well, have COVID-19 symptoms, have recently travelled outside Canada within the past 14 days, or were exposed to someone who has COVID-19, do not come to campus.

Your visit should be no longer than 10 minutes. Please collect your belongings and exit the building promptly.

Wear your mask



You must wear your mask at all times inside SAIT buildings

No smoking on campus



There is no smoking allowed on campus grounds

You are required to follow the safety measures SAIT has in place while you are on campus:

- Wash or sanitize your hands before, during, and after your visit
- go straight to your destination
- take the stairs if possible and limit 2 people per elevator, facing away from the other occupants
- use only designated washrooms and limit use as much as possible
- read and follow all safety signage
- maintain a separation of 2 metres from other people at all times
- exit the building from your entry point

Emergency Response

If you become ill while on campus, immediately notify a SAIT safety ambassador. A designated first aider will escort you to an isolation space where you will complete the online [COVID-19 self-assessment](#) and arrange for safe transportation home. Anyone with COVID-19 symptoms must self-isolate at home.

In the unlikely event of a building evacuation, please exit the building calmly and quickly via the nearest exit and proceed to the closest muster point.
