How to submit a claim

Many health and dental care providers will direct bill The Campus Trust on your behalf. Present your Benefit Card to your health or dental provider in order for them to access the electronic pay-direct system. Using your card allows for immediate claims processing without the need for you to mail in a claim form.

If your provider is unable to submit electronically on your behalf, online claim submission is an easy and practical way to submit your health or dental claims. Once registered, simply log in and select "New Claim" from the left-hand menu.
