GOVERNANCE

ABOUT THE ASSOCIATION

Within Alberta, all student associations and unions are regulated by the Post-Secondary Learning Act; section 95(1). The act prescribes that Saitsa is managed by a board who is elected by and from the members of the association.

Saitsa is governed by 9 student representatives who are elected each year. Saitsa's success is tied directly to these dedicated students. Our Board meets regularly and invites students to attend their meetings to see governance in action. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors (BOD) is composed of student representatives elected during the Winter semester. Their one-year term begins the following Spring (May). The Board provides ongoing ownership linkages with the student body, sets organizational policy in accordance with ownership needs, and provides oversight of Saitsa's operational compliance with its own policies. Within the Board, they elect a President and a Vice-President; these positions are Saitsa's Chief Governance Officers, as well as SAIT Board of Governors Student Representatives.

REGULAR BOARD MEETING ATTENDEES & SUPPORT

Board Advisor

This appointed position supports the Board's governance by acting as a parliamentarian and experienced governance resource for the President, Vice-President and Board as a whole.

Chief Executive Officer

The Chief Executive Officer is responsible for Saitsa's management and day-to-day operations in accordance with organizational policies and strategic direction set by the Board.

Governance Staff

The Saitsa Governance & Advocacy staff support the Board by facilitating its administrative functions and ownership linkage activities, while also ensuring that elections are fair, transparent, and accessible.

Under the Post-Secondary Learning Act, Saitsa is authorized to collect these fees in order to fulfill its mandate to represent and support the student body effectively.

WHO PAYS FEES?

Most full-time and part-time students, as well as apprentices, pay Saitsa membership fees. The actual fee assessment depends on the number of credit hours or apprentice weeks in which a student is enrolled.

<p>\$152</p> <p>Student Association Fee</p>	<p>Helps fund advocacy, student support, and engagement opportunities throughout the year. It ensures students have access to helpful resources, vibrant events, and meaningful ways to get involved. The fee also supports spaces and initiatives that enhance life outside the classroom.</p>
<p>(\$16.89/Credit)</p> <p><i>Fees are paid per credit to a maximum of \$152 per semester.</i></p>	
<p>\$94</p> <p>Dental Fee</p>	<p>Gives students access to a dental benefits plan designed to make routine and unexpected dental care more affordable. It helps cover costs like check-ups, cleanings, and other eligible dental services.</p>
<p>\$96</p> <p>Health Fee</p>	<p>Provides students with access to a comprehensive health benefits plan. It helps cover the cost of medical services not included in provincial healthcare.</p>

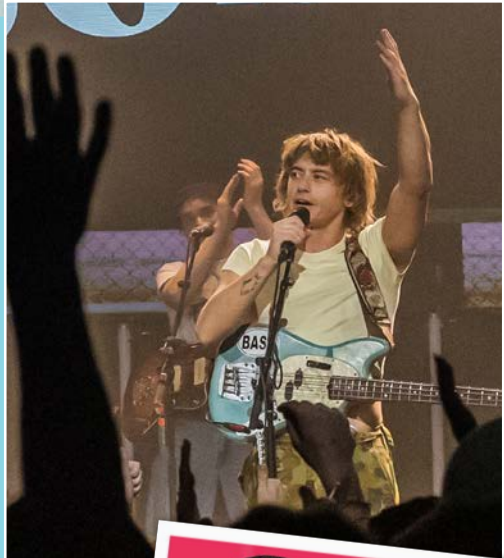

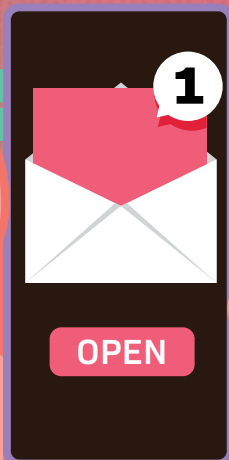

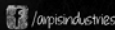
