<h2>Check-In</h2>	<p>10:30 a.m. — 11 a.m.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Please line up at the G&A table (table with the yellow tablecloth) starting at 10:30 a.m. to be assigned your table. Tables are assigned first come first served. * Bring your ID with you for verification. You will receive a Saitsa yellow lanyard and name tag that you must wear during Meet & Greet. * One Campaign Rep may assist you with Meet & Greet. Remember, the Campaign Rep must be already registered online and approved by the Election Committee. The deadline to register your Campaign Rep is February 18th at 11:59 p.m. * The Campaign Rep must check-in at the G&A table and show their ID for verification. They will receive a Saitsa pin and a name tag, with their name and their candidate’s name on it, which they must wear during the event as well.

<p>Check-In (Cont.)</p>	<p>10:30 a.m. — 11 a.m.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Nobody other than the Candidate and one Campaign Rep are allowed behind the table.
<p>Setup</p>	<p>10:30 a.m. — 11 a.m.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Decorate your table however you want. Ensure it does not violate any election policies. * Posters and flyers may be attached to the black drapes behind your table using pins for the duration of the event. However, please <i>DO NOT</i> use pins to attach election materials anywhere else, as doing so would violate election policy. * Food and drink are permitted at the tables for personal consumption or for giveaways.

<h2 style="margin: 0;">Main Event</h2>	<p style="margin: 0;">11 a.m. — 1 p.m.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Speak with as many students as you can to get your message out to the voters. * Flyers, giveaways, and draws are just a few ways to draw student attention to your table. Remember there is no one right way to get your message out there. Be creative and highlight who you are. * All campaign rules apply during Meet & Greet. Make sure you refer to the election policies and guidelines you have been provided. * You are required to include all campaign expenses incurred from Meet & Greet on your expense form with all receipts attached (take photos of your receipts in case you lose the actual receipt). The expense limit is \$300 inclusive of GST and any foreign currency exchange. * Friends and supporters are <u>NOT</u> permitted to loiter by your table during the event. * Have fun! This is all about engaging with your fellow students and showing off your campaign.
